Gregory J. Fleming '88, is a Senior Research Scholar at Yale Law School and Distinguished Visiting Fellow of the Yale Law School Center for the Study of Corporate Law.

Prior to joining Yale Law School, Mr. Fleming was the President and Chief Operating Officer of Merrill Lynch & Co. Mr. Fleming was appointed to those positions in June of 2007.
