

**Richard J. Herring** is Jacob Safra Professor of International Banking and Professor of Finance at The Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania where he is also founding director of The Wharton Financial Institutions Center. From 2000 to 2006, he served as the Director of the Lauder Institute of International Management Studies and, from 1995 to 2000, as Vice Dean and Director of Wharton's Undergraduate Division. He is the author of more than 90 articles, monographs and books on various topics in financial regulation, international banking and international finance. Outside the university, he is co-chair of the US Shadow Financial Regulatory Committee and Executive Director of the Financial Economists Roundtable. He is also a member of the Advisory Boards of the European Banking Report in Rome and the Institute for Financial Studies in Frankfurt and a former fellow of the World Economic Forum in Davos. He serves as an independent director of the DWS mutual fund complex and the Daiwa closed end funds. He received his undergraduate degree from Oberlin College and his PhD from Princeton University.
