

INSTRUCTIONS

International J.D. Students

All students who are not U.S. citizens or permanent residents should follow these steps to apply for financial aid:

Step I. Complete the Yale Law School International Student Application.

- Students who will be 28 years old (or younger) on September 1 need to submit parental information. Students who will be at least 29 years old on September 1 do not need to submit parental information.
- Married students need to submit their spouse's information.

Deadline: **Incoming** students must complete the **Yale Law School International Student Application** by **March 15, 2009**. For **continuing** students the deadline is **April 15, 2009**.

Step II. After you receive your award letter:

- To apply for **private student loans** up to the amount indicated, please complete the Notification & Confirmation form that is available online at <http://www.law.yale.edu/admissions/finaidforms.htm>.
- To accept the **scholarships/grants** specified in your award letter, you must complete the Yale Law School Financial Aid Questionnaire survey and submit the following forms:

 2. Statement of Educational Purpose Form _____
 3. Submit a copy of your 2008 Federal Income Tax Return and W2 _____
(signed copy) or your country's equivalent for you and your spouse.
If you are not required to file a federal income tax return, a non-filer statement (at our website) is required.

If you will be 28 years old or younger on September 1, please also submit:

1. Copies of your parents' 2008 Federal Income Tax Return and W2s _____
(signed copy) or your country's equivalent. If your parents are not required to file a federal income tax return, a non-filer statement is required.
2. Sibling Enrollment Verification Form (if applicable) – _____
due 10/30/09

Deadline: All required forms and tax documents (except the Sibling Enrollment Verification Form) are due in the Financial Aid Office by **May 4, 2009**. No funds will be disbursed until we have received all required forms.
